

Trophy Elk Hunt

Tejon Ranch is consistently ranked as one of the top Rocky Mountain Elk hunting destinations in the United States; elk herd management, mild winters, abundant feed, and very limited hunting pressure allow the elk to flourish. Located just an hour and a half north of Los Angeles, you will find yourself in some of the best elk hunting habitat found in the world.

Our trophy elk hunts are a six-day, six-night hunt (hunt to harvest applies) including lodging, meals, transportation on the ranch, basic field care of game and transportation to the local taxidermist and meat processor if needed. One (non-hunter) guest is also included with this hunt. This is a one-on-one guided hunt with other guide(s) helping to scout the 270,000-acre ranch for trophy quality bulls. Tejon Ranch's skilled guides and support staff will provide you with a truly unique elk hunting experience and the chance at a trophy of a lifetime.

Schedule:

Hunts typically start at (1:00 pm) on the day of arrival at the Tejon Ranch Wildlife Management Office (4427 Lebec Rd. Lebec, CA 93243). After checking in and viewing the orientation video you will be escorted to your hunting cabin by your guide or another ranch representative. Each hunter will be required to sight in their rifle or bow before going to the field and a shooting range is available to ensure your rifle or bow is on target. You will then sit down for a nice dinner before you head out for your first evening's hunt. You can generally expect to hunt in the mornings until the elk activity has slowed, and again in the afternoon. There will be a lull in the middle of the day that will allow you the time to rest and prepare for the afternoon hunt. We will be sitting down to early dinners at this time of the year allowing us to stay out until last light maximizing the best hunting hours. This schedule will continue through the morning hunt of the last day when we exit the Ranch.

Accommodations:

All guided hunts on Tejon Ranch are "all-inclusive". We will provide all the lodging and meals while you are here on the ranch (excluding alcohol). Our cabins are equipped with all the basic needs including hot showers, towels, bedding, and provide a great atmosphere for hunters to enjoy their time on the Ranch. Meals will include a continental breakfast, lunch and dinner.

What to Bring:

Hunters are expected to come prepared for vast and varying terrain, changing weather conditions, and basic needs (i.e., game bags and/or coolers) for transporting game when

Management Elk Hunt

Tejon Ranch is consistently ranked as one of the top Rocky Mountain Elk hunting destinations in the United States; mild winters, abundant feed, and very limited hunting pressure allow the elk to flourish. Located just an hour and a half north of Los Angeles, you will find yourself in some of the best elk hunting habitat found in the world.

Our management elk hunts are a three-day hunt over a four-day period (hunt to harvest applies) including lodging, meals, transportation on the ranch, basic field care of game and transportation to the local taxidermist and meat processor if needed. Management bulls do not have a minimum or maximum score but are defined as "a mature bull exhibiting characteristics that are not conducive to herd quality". This is a one-on-one guided hunt with other guide(s) helping to scout the 270,000-acre ranch for management bulls. The determination as to whether the bull fits the "management" criteria is at the guide's discretion and is based on the bull's maturity and antler configuration. Our guides will work hard to find the best possible bull that meets the management criteria.

Schedule:

Hunts typically start at (1:00 pm) on the day of arrival at the Tejon Ranch Wildlife Management Office (4427 Lebec Rd. Lebec, CA 93243). After checking in and viewing the orientation video you will be escorted to your hunting cabin by your guide or another ranch representative. Each hunter will be required to sight in their rifle or bow before going to the field and a shooting range is available to ensure your rifle or bow is on target. You will then sit down for a nice dinner before you head out for your first evening's hunt.
